

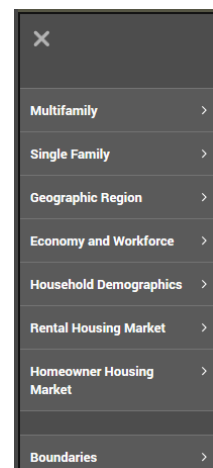
Property Search


To center the map on your property of interest, use the search header to enter in an address, city, county, state or zipcode. This will zoom the map to that location.




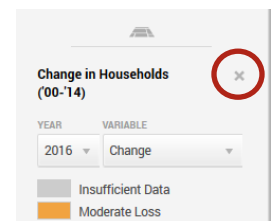
Adding or Changing Layers


1. To add a geographic scoring criterion, click the **“NEW MAP”**  icon found in the upper-left corner of the mapping application. This will display a menu of options in a sidebar (shown to the right).
2. Click **“Multifamily”** to display the geographic priorities. If you are working on a Single Family RFP application click **“Single Family.”**
3. Click the geographic scoring criterion you would like to add to the map. By default the layers are added to the map as one shade of blue.
4. To take out the underlying thematic map about change in number of households,



click **“EXPAND LEGEND”**  found in the legend of the map in the upper-right corner of the application. Click the **“X”** in the legend, which is highlighted to the right with the red circle.

5. Click **“Filter,”**  then click **“Type”**, and finally **“Color Code All”** to display the different priority types for that criterion.



6. To print the map as shown on the screen, click the three vertical dots icon  found in the upper-right corner of mapping application.

Then click **“PRINT.”**  This will print a PDF version of the map as it is currently being displayed.
