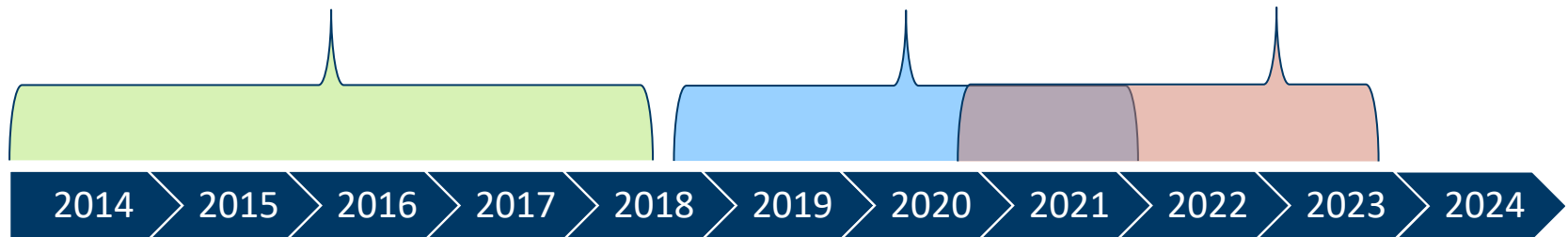

- 277 families



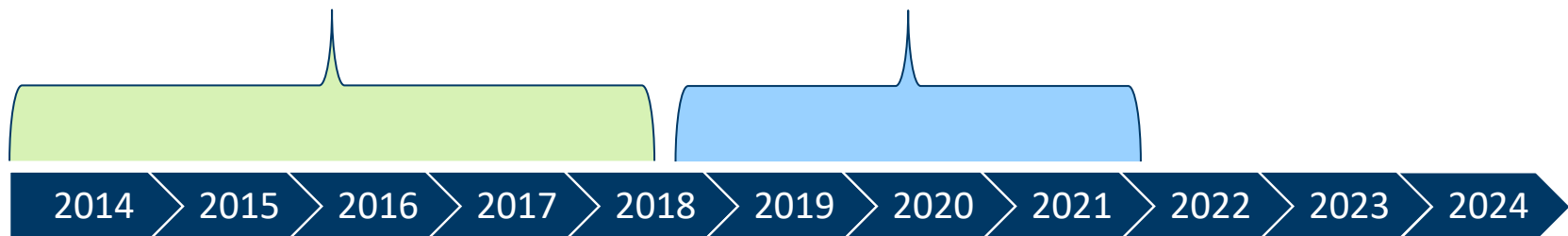

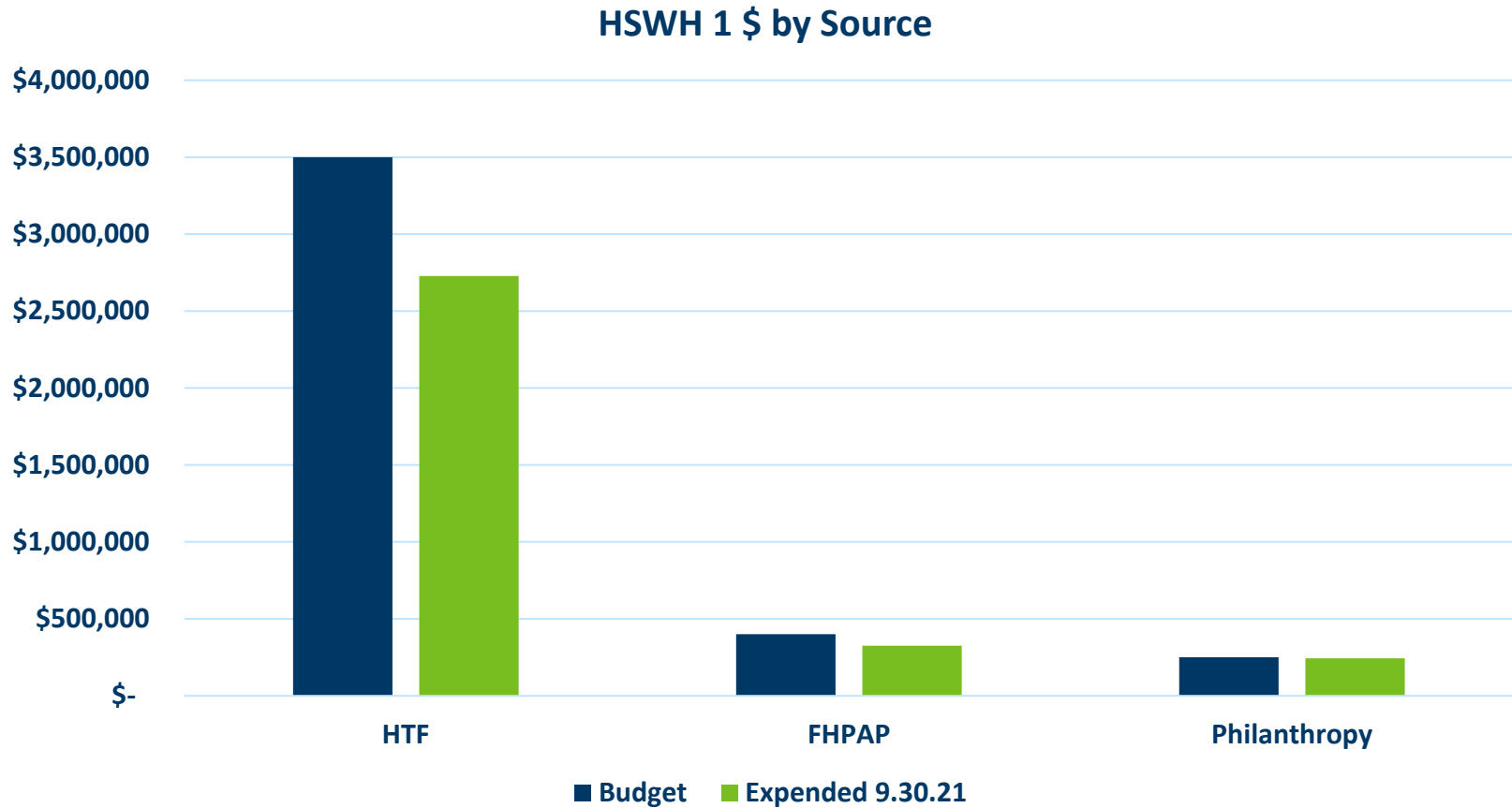

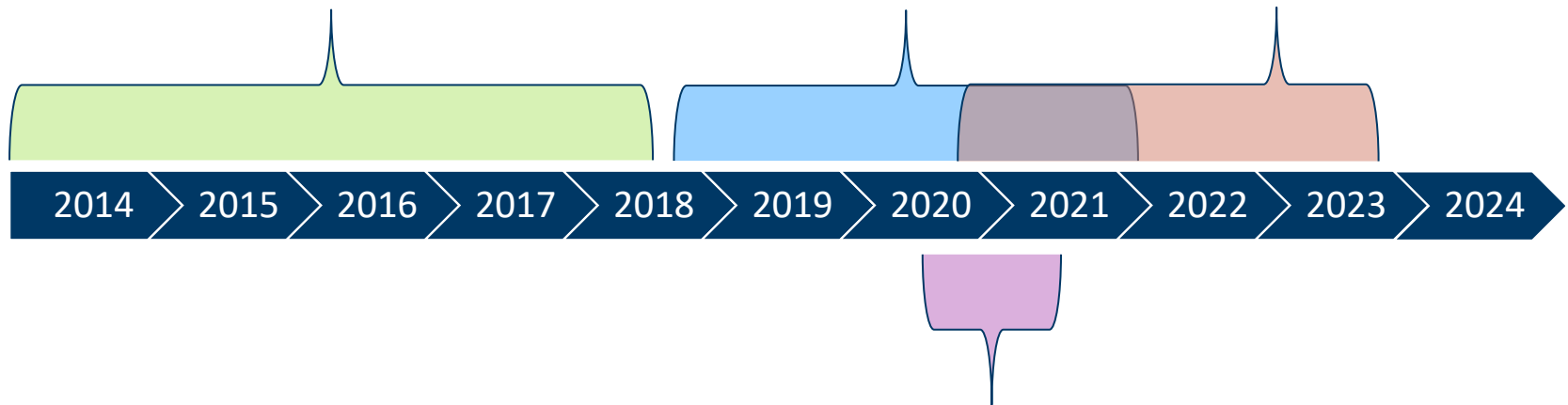

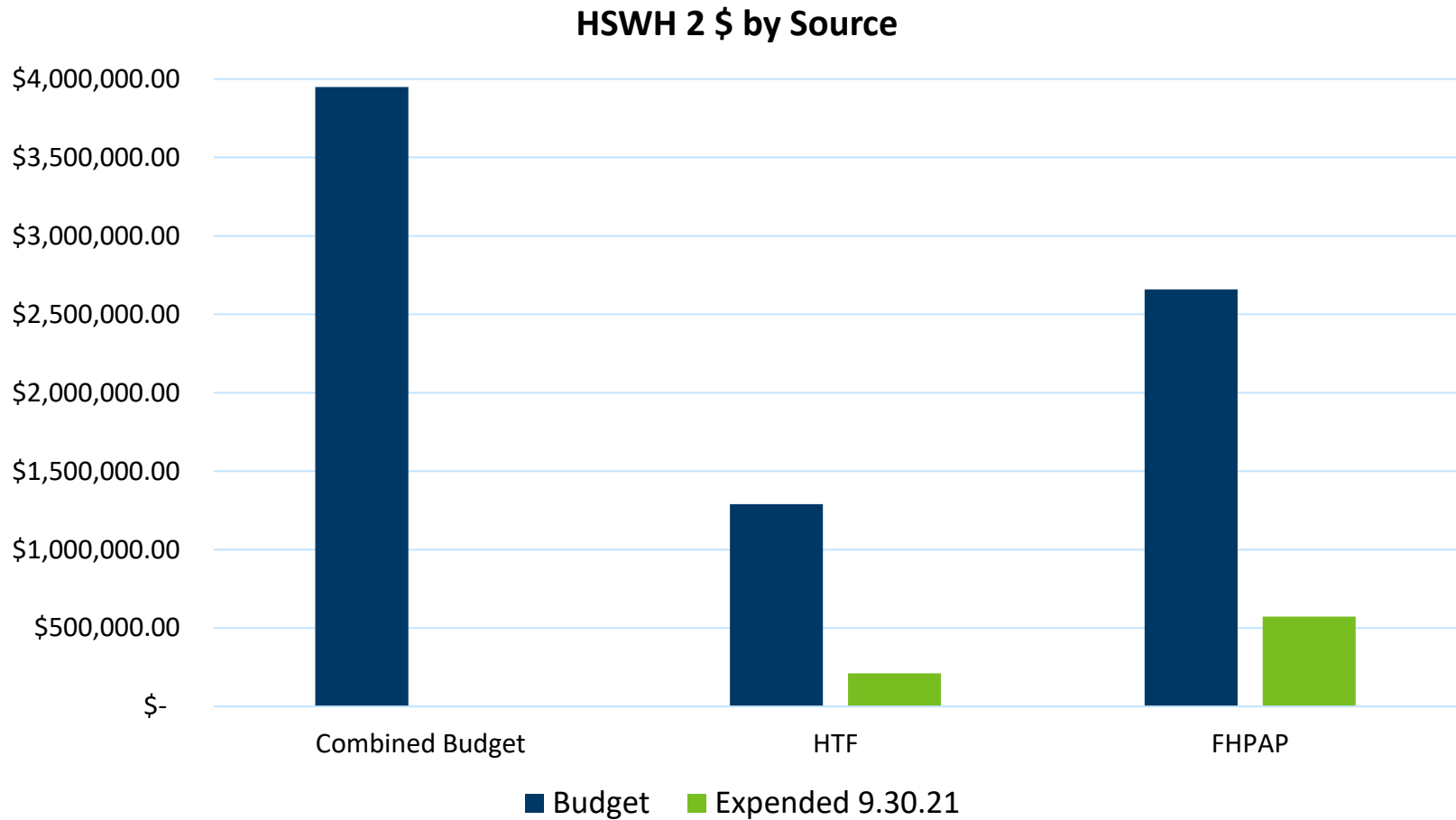

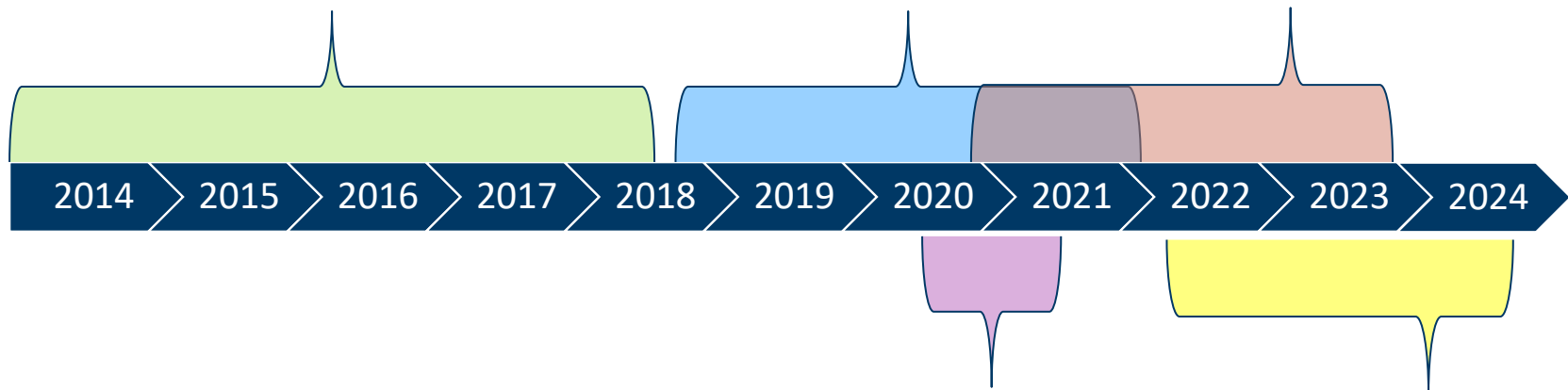

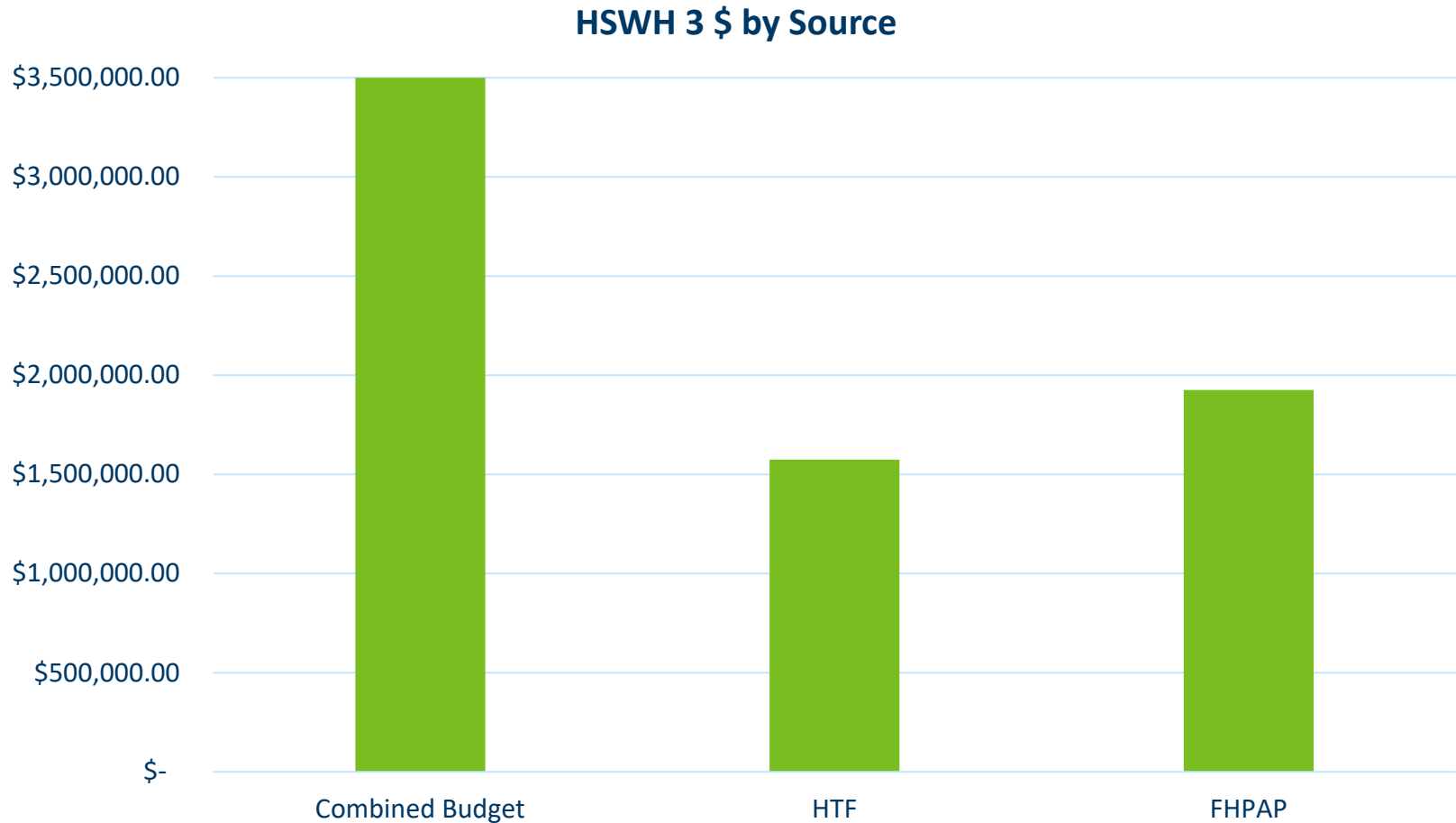
