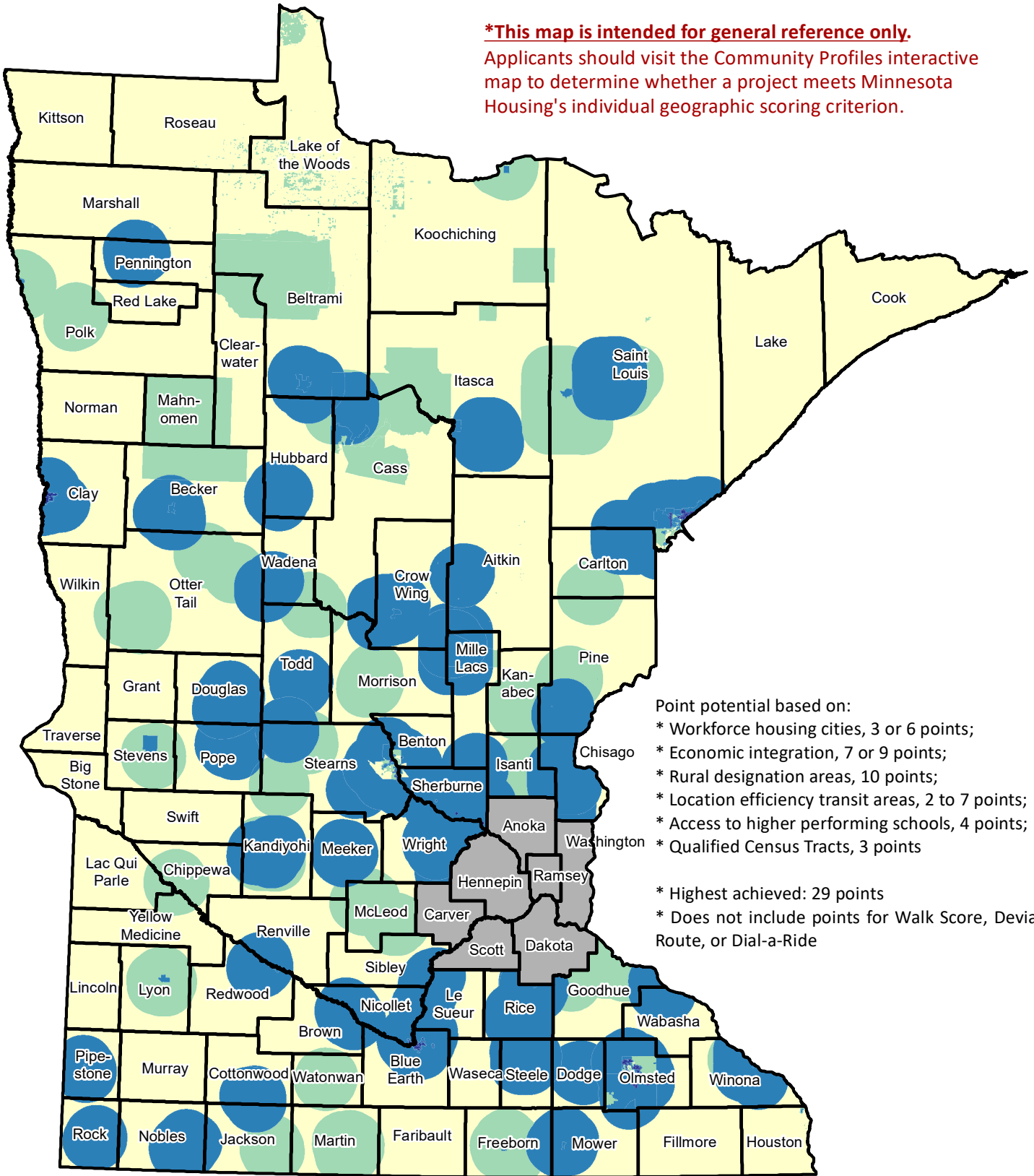


Combined Geographic Priority Point Potential, 2021 QAP: Greater Minnesota

Applicants should visit the Community Profiles interactive map to determine whether a project meets Minnesota Housing's individual geographic scoring criterion.



- Point potential based on:
- * Workforce housing cities, 3 or 6 points;
 - * Economic integration, 7 or 9 points;
 - * Rural designation areas, 10 points;
 - * Location efficiency transit areas, 2 to 7 points;
 - * Access to higher performing schools, 4 points;
 - * Qualified Census Tracts, 3 points
- * Highest achieved: 29 points
 * Does not include points for Walk Score, Deviated Route, or Dial-a-Ride

Combined Points	Color
1 - 10	Light Yellow
11 - 15	Light Green
16 - 20	Medium Blue
21 - 29	Dark Blue
