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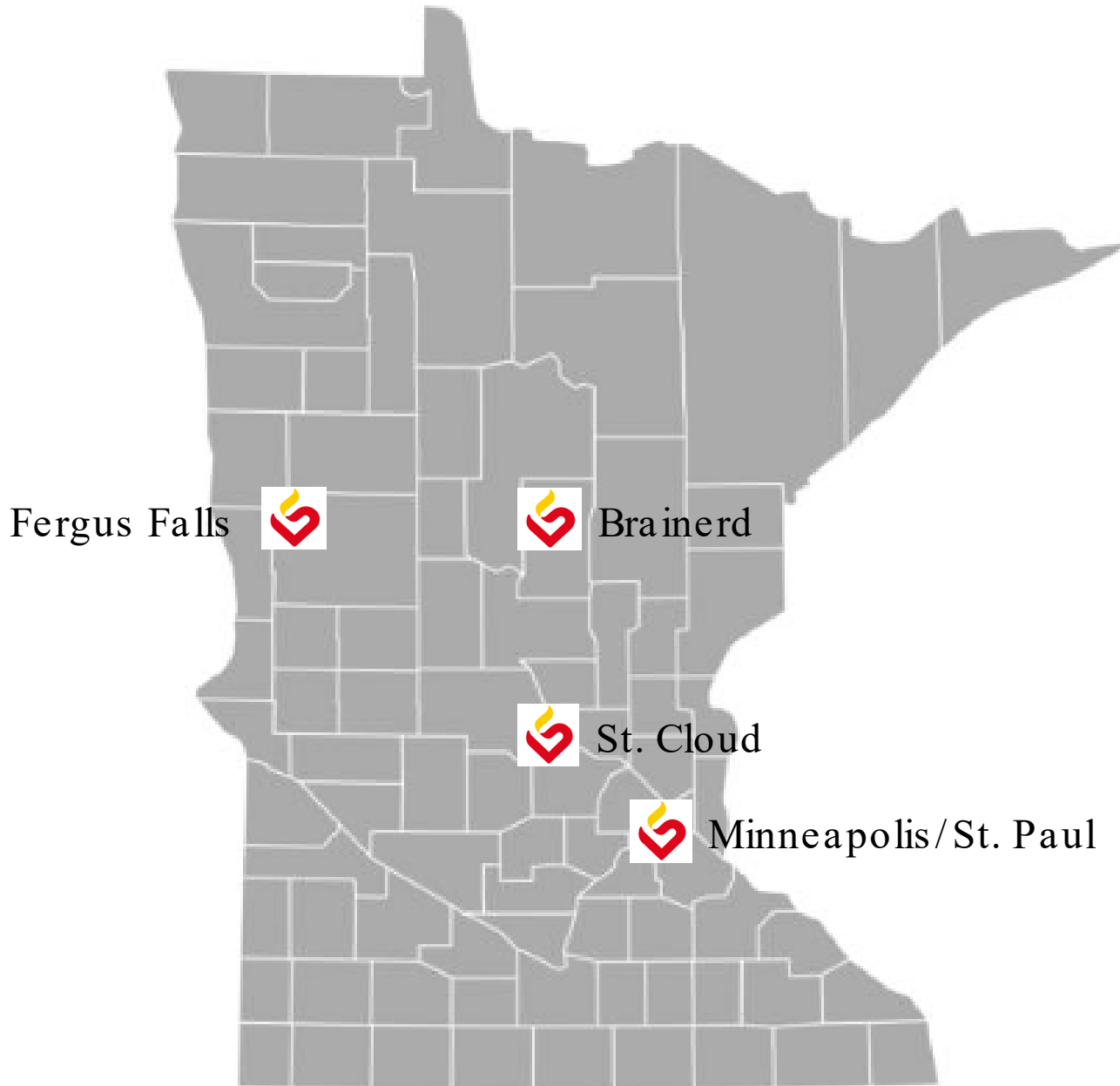

 - Less than 1% of exits in FHPAP Rapid reHousing program returned to homelessness
