

Regional Planning Grant to Prevent and End Homelessness Request for Proposals Frequently Asked Questions

Published: April 7, 2026

Grant Period: January 1, 2027-December 31, 2028

Application deadline: Thursday, May 14, 2026, at noon Central time.

Q1. Are the presentation slides from the Regional Planning Grant RFP Information Session and the recording of the session available?

A1. Yes, the recording of the session and the presentation slides are posted on Minnesota Housing's [Regional Planning Grant to Prevent & End Homelessness](#) webpage.

Q2. The RFP includes two categories: 1) planning support and capacity enhancement and 2) innovation. Is funding set aside for each category?

A2. No. There is up to \$900,000 available across both categories combined. We have not set a specific amount for each category, as recommended awards for these two activities will be based on several factors including, but not limited to, the number of applications received, the funding amount requested, scoring results, demonstrated capacity needs, and geographic coverage. This flexible approach allows us to allocate funding where it can have the greatest impact.

Q3. What form(s) should a Tribe or Tribal Housing Authority complete for the pre-award risk assessment and/or certification of no felony financial crimes convictions?

A3. Tribal governments are not subject to the pre-award risk assessment. However, Tribal-affiliated organizations with a nonprofit or for-profit business designation with the Minnesota Secretary of State *are* subject to the requirements.
