Minnesota Housing's loan commitment system is experiencing intermittent issues when trying to upload a closed loan package. We are aware of this issue and apologize for any inconvenience this may be causing. Our vendor is working to resolve this quickly and hopes to have a solution in place as early as next week.

Until this is resolved, it is acceptable to not upload the closed loan package. Please make sure you are still completing the True & Certify process in the system before the interest rate expires.
